# Okinawa Prefecture Emigrant Descent Student Program Requirements

## Set forth by the Okinawa International Exchange & Human Resources Development Foundation

---

### Objective

This student program is designated to provide superior students of Okinawan descent a scholarship to study at accredited institutions (universities) in Okinawa Prefecture. Through this program, students will enhance their understanding of Japanese culture, industry, education and society and will have opportunities to interact with local Okinawans. The program is geared to produce human resources who will contribute extensively to their home countries and act as an intermediary for Okinawa and their home country.

### Host Institution

Students will enroll as auditors or research students at nationally-ranked, University of the Ryukyus, Meio University or Okinawa Prefectural University of Arts.

### Duration of Study

Scholarship students for the year 2009 will study or research at host institution for a one year period, April 1, 2009 to March 31, 2010.

### Scholarship - Expenses

Okinawa International Exchange & Human Resources Development Foundation will cover the following student expenses for their studies at host institutions in Okinawa.

Travel (International)	Actual expenses Incurred	Includes international airfare to/from home country and Naha airports, and transportation fees between airports in Japan.
Enrollment	Actual expenses Incurred	Includes fees for application, examination, entrance, and tuition.

Health & Welfare	51,000 yen	Health and accident insurance during duration of study

\* Please note that above expenses is subject to change. Students are responsible for expenses for passports, visas, airport taxes and others not listed above. Room & Board expenses for April (first month) will be calculated on a daily basis from your first day of arrival.

### **Scholarship - Cancellation of Scholarship**

If a student takes a leave of absence, is suspended or leaves school for personal reasons or breaking oath during his/her duration of study in Okinawa, the scholarship may be revoked entirely or partially.

### **Eligibility**

Applicants must:

1. Be of Okinawan descent and recommended by the Kenjinkai president. Applicants must have a sound mind and body and be recognized as a person capable of playing a leading role at work or in communities.
2. Have completed twelve years of education in his/her home country or hold higher academic knowledge and meet the requirements of host institutions.
3. Be born after April 2, 1978 (under 30 years old).
4. Possess Japanese language skills sufficient enough to study at host institutions.  
(holder of the 3rd grade Japanese language proficiency)
5. Hold a Japanese Language Proficiency First Level qualification (for research student candidates only).
6. Have financial support to cover any expenses that exceed the scholarship provided by OIHF.
7. Have relatives in Okinawa who can assist him/her during his/her stay and act as guardian.
