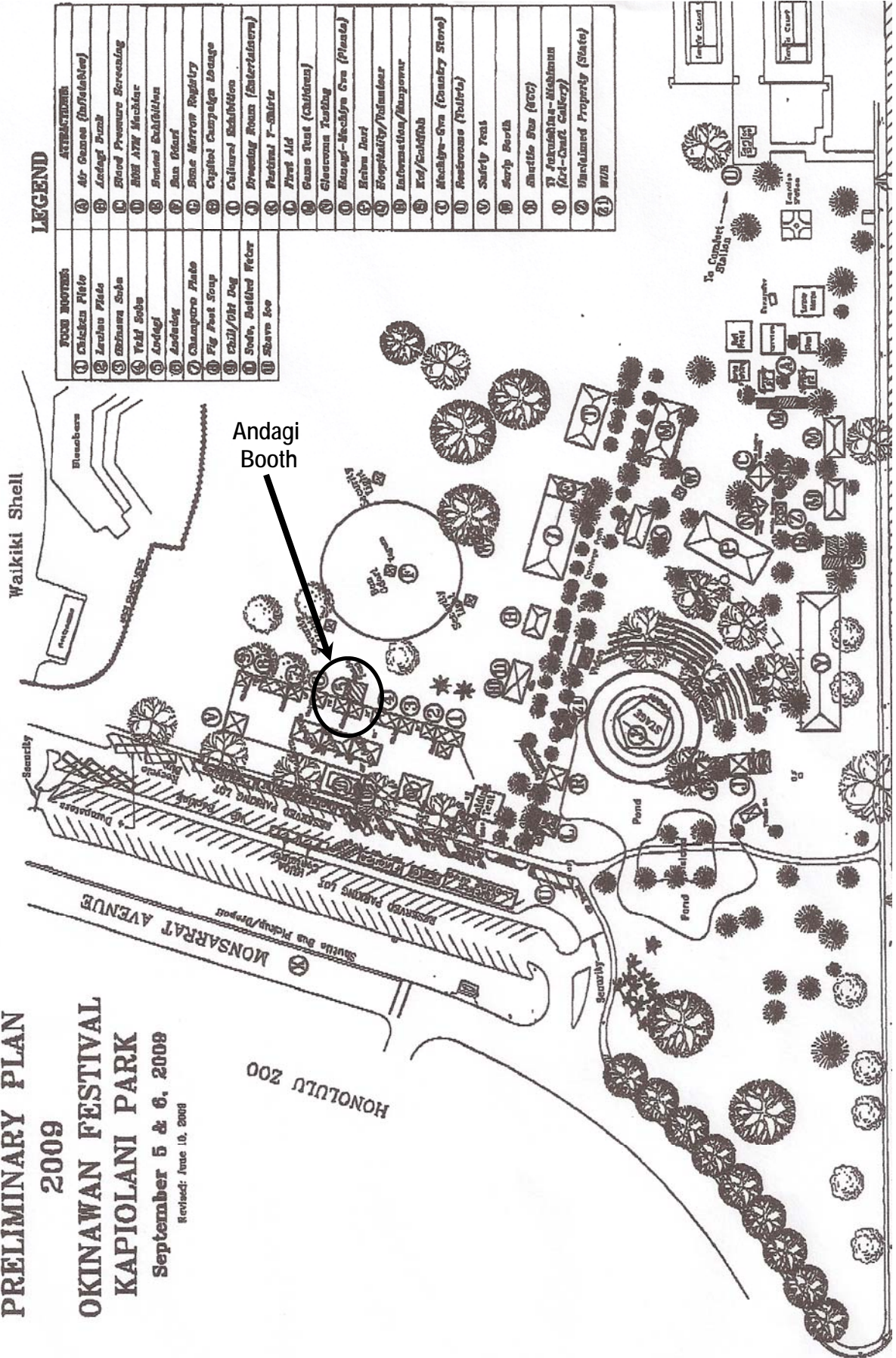
Members should mail (**checks only**) or drop off cash from scrip sales to their assigned Club Officer.

The deadline for turning in un-sold scrip’s to HUOA is August 5, 2009, therefore the Haebaru Club members must turn in their unsold scrip’s by Saturday, August 1, 2009 (which has passed). The unsold scrip’s **must** be turned in to Faith Hamao by this date. Money for scrip’s should be turned in to our treasurer Faith Hamao. Last year the Haebaru Club sold 4,750 scrip’s. This year (with all our member’s help) we hope to reach our 5,000 goal to help our club’s treasury ! Our club tends to make a profit of 30% of the scrip’s sold.

This year the Haebaru Club will again be selling freshly cooked, delicious andagi. Andagi sales will be on Sunday, September 6, 2009 from 8:00 AM in the morning to 12:00 PM. Please wear your HAEBARU shirts and headgear to cover your hair if you will be handling food. Gloves will be furnished. Bring thongs if you need one. Interested volunteers’ contact one of the Haebaru Officers listed above with the name(s) and contact telephone number(s). Use the sign-up sheet (see page 6) and mail. Due to the double booth layout put into effect a year ago, we need all the help we can get. We estimate we’ll need about thirty workers to man the booth. Remember it is not all work, it is also a fun event to be able to socialize with all your friends so come out and help our club. Volunteers will check-in and check-out with Thomas Otaguro, the Haebaru Club booth coordinator. A food voucher and shuttle ride voucher (return ride if you parked at KCC) will be handed to you before you start. On the following page is the Okinawan Festival map as of June 2009. You will notice the orientation of the food booths have changed. The Andagi booth is still at it’s old location, but the other food booths are now alongside the Andagi booth (on both sides).

**OXTAIL SOUP**

- 1 tray oxtail cut in pieces
- 1 cup raw, shelled peanuts
- 1 clove garlic, crushed
- 1 piece ginger, crushed
- 2 stalks green onion, cut in 1" lengths
- ¼ cup sake or sherry
- Salt to taste

- Garnish:
- Chinese parsley and/or mustard cabbage
  - Grated ginger
  - Minced green onions, optional

Parboil oxtail for 5 minutes, drain. Add all ingredients except the garnish. Simmer in water about 3 inches above ingredients until oxtail is tender, about 3 ½ hours. It is best to prepare the night before. Refrigerate overnight and skim off fat before reheating for serving. Serve with chopped parsley and grated ginger.

Variation: After about 2 hours of cooking, you may add dried mushrooms (soaked and sliced), bamboo shoots, celery, round onion and carrots, sliced. Long rice soaked in water and cut into 2-inch pieces may also be added. Add 1 can of chicken broth when some of the liquid evaporates. Season to taste with salt, pepper and a pinch of sugar.
