Conversational Japanese Elementary I/II (A14900)

An introduction to the basic structure of the Japanese language, including proper pronunciation, grammar, basic vocabulary, and simple everyday conversation.

Elementary I follows lessons 1 through 6 and Elementary II lessons 6+ of *Japanese for Busy People, Volume I*.

In addition to the lessons, classes include language study through games, activities, demonstrations of Japanese culture, and practice with experienced Japanese language speakers.

Intermediate students use *Japanese for Busy People, Volume III* to build on knowledge gained in Intermediate Japanese Conversation I–VI. In addition to the lessons, classes include language study through games, activities, demonstrations of Japanese culture, and practice with experienced Japanese language speakers.

Advanced students use the latest news from NHK, Japanese newspapers, and a variety teaching materials, developing Japanese speaking and listening skills as you focus on timely and interesting topics in Japan. In addition to the lessons, classes include language study through brushing up Japanese grammar for the JLPT and Japanese conversation practice with experienced Japanese native speakers.
