Jun 13 SUNDAY OKINAWA – TOKYO/ HANEDA

7:00-9:30a.m. Breakfast at hotel.

10:00a.m. Check-out of the hotel. Transfer to Naha Domestic Airport bound for Tokyo.

12:30p.m. Depart on Japan Airlines #904 bound for Tokyo/ Haneda.

2:50p.m. Arrive Tokyo/ Haneda Airport. Pickup your own baggage and transfer to Shin Yokohama Prince Hotel. This hotel is connected to Shopping Plaza Pepe, Bic Camera, and JR Shin Yokohama Train Station. (B)

Jun 14 MONDAY YOKOHAMA – KAMAKURA - HAKONE

Breakfast at hotel. Check-out of the hotel.

8:30a.m. Depart Yokohama for sightseeing to Kamakura and Hakone.

In Kamakura, you will be visiting Tsurugaoka Hachimangu Shrine as well as shops along the Komachi shopping street. The massive bronze statue of the great Buddha at the Kotokuin Temple. It is the second largest Buddha statue in Japan, the bronze image measures 37 feet and is thought to date back in 1252.

In Hakone, cruise on Lake Ashi and staying 1 night at Hotel Kowakien.

Hakone is well known resort that includes many renowned hot springs.

At Kowakien, you can enjoy hot spring bath (onsen furo) and fabulous buffet dinner. (B , D)

Jun 15 TUESDAY HAKONE – MT. FUJI – TOKYO

Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out of the hotel.

8:30a.m. Depart Hakone for sightseeing tour of Mt. Fuji and Tokyo.

1st stop will be Mt. Fuji Visitor Center, we will be watching a video of Mt. Fuji's 4 seasons and inside the center is a small gift shop.

Mt. Fuji's 5th Station is 2,305meters above sea level, got couple souvenir shops.

After the tour of Mt. Fuji, we will be going to Tokyo via Tomei Espressway Toll Way. Making 1 stop at Ebina Service Area for lunch and restroom break.

In Tokyo, we will be making one stop at Asakusa Kannon Temple (also known as Sensoji Temple). Colorful stalls of Nakamise arcade, join visitors and locals who come to shop for souvenirs, manju, okoshi (puff rice), senbei (rice crackers), and etc.

Continuation of Jun 15, Tuesday:

After Asakusa, we will be heading to our hotel in Shinagawa.

We will be staying 3 nights at Hotel Pacific Tokyo. The hotel is located 5 minutes walk from JR Shinagawa Station.

If you are not tired then you can take the hotel courtesy shuttle to their sister property, Grand Pacific in Odaiba. Aqua City, shopping mall, also have souvenir shops, Disney Store, Starbuck, food court & lots of restaurants. (B)

Jun 16 & Jun 17 WEDNESDAY & THURSDAY TOKYO

Breakfast at the hotel.

Two whole days are yours to explore Tokyo on your own. Anyone wanting to go to Tokyo Disneyland or Tokyo Disney Sea on this day should make prior arrangements with N & K Travel Service for admission tickets and/or shuttle reservations prior to leaving Hawaii. (B)

The courtesy shuttles to Tokyo Disneyland and Tokyo Disney Sea departs at 7:30am, 9:50am, and 10:40am. The return times are as follows: 6:30pm, 7:30pm, and 10:15pm.
